

Opening information

of the zoological park, the Lez nature reserve and the Montmaur wood

As part of the forest fires prevention, the regulation sets 6 levels of risk depending on meteorological factors :
low, light, moderate, severe, very severe and exceptional.

For your safety, Montpellier city issued a decree (n°2013/0573/T/R) stating :

- The Lez nature reserve, the Montmaur wood and parts of the zoological park are closed to the public in case of severe fire risk,

- The zoological park, the Lez nature reserve and the Montmaur wood are all closed to the public in case of very severe or exceptional fire risk.

We invite you to inquire about the fire risk in the park before your visit by calling the following number :

Warning : the Lez nature reserve may be closed at any time depending on the risk (fire, flood, strong wind...).

In case of alert, you must strictly observe the instructions given by the security staff and evacuate the park calmly.

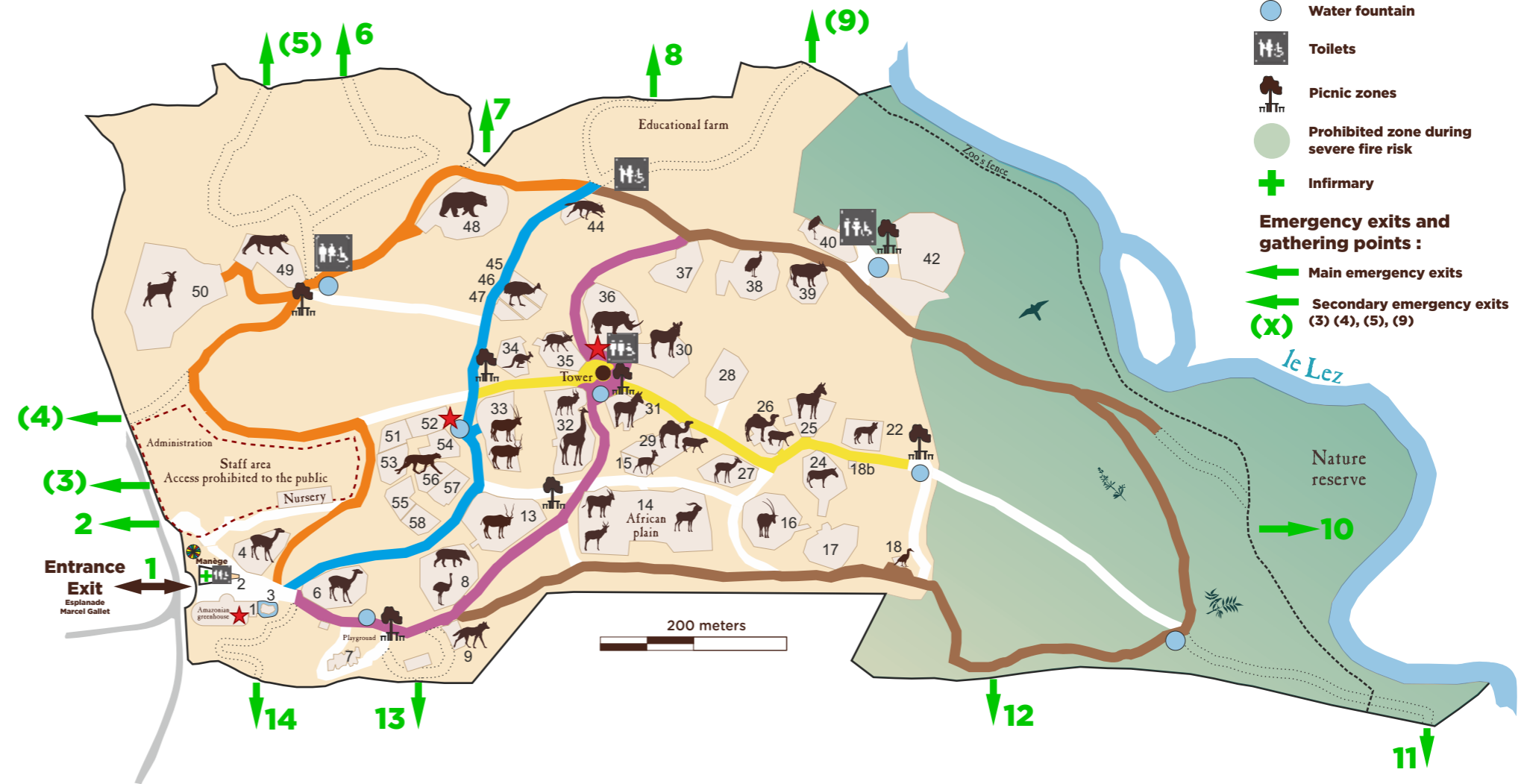

Zoological park and Amazonian greenhouse

1st of April to 30th of September	9h30-18h30
1st to 31st of October	10h-18h
1st of November to 31st of January	10h-17h
1st of February to 31st of March	10h-18h

Access to the Amazonian greenhouse is no longer possible 1h before closing.

Access to the Zoological park is no longer possible 30min before closing.

The Lez nature reserve

1st of April to 30th of September	9h30-18h
1st to 31st of October	10h-17h30
1st of November to 31st of January	10h-16h30
1st of February to 31st of March	10h-17h30

Security agents begin the exit of the public 30min before closing.

**Closed on Mondays, except on holiday Mondays
or during school holidays of zone C.**
